FOCUS OF THE EVENT

During the 1st round of ANITA pilots the LEA partners for the first time worked with the 1st release of the integrated ANITA platform. All six LEA partners setup their local virtual pilot environment and performed end-user evaluation tests based on developed horizontal scenarios. Collecting feedback about improvements for the technical partners to work for the 2nd release of the ANITA platform

MAIN OUTCOMES

- All 6 ANITA LEAs were directly involved in pilot execution and provided valuable opinions and suggestions on its benefit, performance and usability.
- In total 24 completed feedback questionnaires were received from the LEA pilot participants plus the results of the 6 focus group discussions that were organized after the local pilots.
- Overall the 1st round of Pilots of the ANITA Platform have been well received. The presence of Technical Partners enabled detailed answers to be provided to the various questions that arose in the course of the presentations and pilot execution
- The feedback provided by all the attendees will enable technical Partners to further refine the platform and produce increasingly relevant and focused tools
